The Board of Trustees shall ensure equal access to instructional materials and information and communication technology (ICT) for all, and particularly for, individuals with disabilities in a timely manner.

As it relates to equally effective alternative access to instructional materials and ICT, timely manner means that the individual with a disability receives access to the instructional materials or ICT at the same time as an individual without a disability.

The Chancellor shall establish administrative procedures to comply with the requirements specified in Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and its implementing regulations, as well as all other accessibility requirements of federal and state laws.
